Skills for Rally and Obedience Competition (beginning April 8th)

This class will include practice of skills needed to successfully compete in rally and obedience competition. Included skills are: off leash heeling, recalls, turns, pivots, sits, downs, stand and stays practice in different situations to strengthen attention and accuracy.

Therapy Dog (beginning April 8th)		
Mondays, 6:40 to 7:40 PM	Instructors: Linda LaPier, Heidi Sample	Class Enrollment Limit: 6
This class is intended to teach and review skills necessary to pass a therapy dog evaluation. A therapy dog must have outstanding temperament and be willing to happily interact with people. The dog should also be able to tolerate other dogs without showing dominant behaviors. Dogs must master basic obedience skills such as, sit, down, stay, "leave it", come and loose leash walking.		
Prerequisites/Notes:		
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Advanced Obedience, CGC, or Welcome to the Real World classes.• Dogs must be at least one year of age by the end of the classes.• Teams will have the opportunity to be tested for a therapy dog evaluation at the end of the eight-week class.• Classes meet weekly for a total of eight weeks.

Puppy Kindergarten (beginning April 9th)		
Tuesdays, 5:30 to 6:20 PM	Instructors: Wendy & John Annette	Class Enrollment Limit: 7
Puppy Kindergarten will offer positive training techniques to teach your puppy to sit, down, stand, target, come when called, walk politely on leash and more. Puppies will have opportunities to explore items they may not encounter at home. Training will be done on-leash with food rewards. The AKC S.T.A.R. Puppy evaluation will be offered during the last class. Additional information about the AKC S.T.A.R. Puppy program is available at akc.org.		
Prerequisites/Notes:		
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Puppies must be less than six months old on the first day of class.• Each puppy must have an adult handler.• Children may only attend if they can sit quietly and NOT interact with the puppies during class.• Classes meet weekly for a total of ten weeks.• The first class is an orientation for people/handlers only.• Puppies do NOT attend the first class.

Prerequisites/Notes:

- Each dog must have an adult handler.
- Participants must have successfully completed Puppy Kindergarten or a Basic Obedience/Manners class.
- Dogs must **NOT** be aggressive or reactive around unfamiliar people and dogs.
- This class is not appropriate for children.
- Classes meet weekly for a total of ten weeks.

Do you enjoy spending time with your dog out-of-doors? Tracking is an informal, unpressured activity in which both handler and dog receive several side benefits: relaxation, physical conditioning, and development of a stronger bond.

Prerequisites/Notes:

- Dogs must be at least six months of age.
- Dogs and handlers must be physically fit and be prepared to attend class outside, rain or shine.
- Classes meet weekly for a total of six weeks.
