Training Your Dog to Hunt for Shed Deer Antlers

All dogs of all breeds have the genetic code in their background to naturally and instinctively search for just about anything that has an aroma. With a nose sensitivity a hundred times more intense than that of humans, all canines have the ability to hunt for shed antlers if given the necessary training.

Prerequisites/Notes:

- Beginner Tracking (These dogs have already been taught to follow a scent, but the important part of their training has taught them to keep their noses to the ground.)
- Dogs should have the following skills:
 - o Pick up an object (toy, ball, frisbie, etc.)
 - Retrieve of an object
 - o Good recall
- Materials required:
 - o Long line
 - o 6' leash
- The majority of the training will be done in a fenced area of 80' x 120' and/or on a long line.
- Classes meet weekly for a total of six weeks.
