Animalistik.com creator L. Morello spoke about his website which he would like to pull together all the plaes that one might access when getting a pet. You could Google but you have to be specific. Petfinder has listings of a lot of organizations, some vets and a lot of shelters and rescue groups and a fairly comprehensive list that you could search in your area. L. Morello indicated that he didn't think all the resources were listed in the area. He wants to start with the larger pet organizations in the area and have a directory for them. He wants his website to be transparent and would like participants to help to develop and evolve the website. It would be a resource website; i.e., what do we want to see for information on this website? He sent out inquiries to a few organizations and received very few responses back from it. Currently the website is just a spreadsheet but it won't remain that way. It will be searchable and give flexibility to search in your specific area.

You can be listed for free on the website in the spreadsheet. If you wanted an ad or DONATE NOW button, there would be a small fee. There was some discussion as to whether we need more than a listing if it points to our own website. L. Morello only briefly looked at our website to get basic information then followed up with email or call to organization to confirm if information was correct.

They have 40 acres and three fields get moved by local farmers. It is a great way to work with your dog and the dog runs the show. It is really fun.
