

Pre-Novice / Advanced Beginners Course

For dogs with basic obedience training.

Objective: To increase the attention span of your dog and improve his reaction to the commands. New commands are introduced.

Training consists of:

- Having dogs full attention for a minimum of 60 seconds.
- Correct heel position. Heeling on lead with full attention on the handler for a minimum of 20 paces.
- Quick response to the commands sit and down.
- Performing a finish to the left or to the right of the handler on command.
- Doing a 1 minute sit stay and a 3 minute down stay on lead.
- Coming when called from a sit stay at the end of a 20 ft. long line.
- Standing without moving with the handler 6 feet in front of the dog on lead while another person does a 3-touch exam.
- Sitting or standing quietly while another person brushes him, picks up each front foot and handles his ears.
- Remaining quietly with another person while his handler is out of sight for 3 minutes.
- Demonstrating the ability to leave an object alone when handler gives leave it command.
