Family Pet Manners/ Basic Obedience

As each individual person and dog has different needs, this will not be a cookie cutter class. Instead, I hope to address those skills which are the most important to each of you in a fun way to further your relationship with your canine companion. Be forewarned that I will challenge you and your dog to think. Among the skills we'll examine are approaches to teaching your dog to happily respond to cues such as sit, down, targeting, coming when called, loose leash walking and focus. We will include games and exercises to elicit voluntary attention, connection, and cooperation.

Instruction to Rally/Rally Novice

Rally is a fun competition sport that requires teamwork between the dog and handler along with performance skills similar to obedience building relationship and skills as dog and handler teams make their way through a course performing the fun skills called for by the Rally signs. Examples of signs found in Rally Novice include such skills as coming to a halt, asking your dog to sit and stay as you walk around him or her. Other signs include, fast pace or slow pace, asking your dog to lie down, left & right turns, pivoting with your dog from a sit, calling your dog to you as you walk 1 step, 2 steps, 3 steps back, circling 360 degrees, weaving and spiraling through cones with your dog, and so on. This Introduction to Rally Skills class will introduce students to the Rally Novice signs, teaching approaches by which to perform the skills with increasing precision and subsequently running through fun courses which will incorporate those signs the following week. Rally Novice is the beginning level of Rally and is worked completely on leash. Even students with experience in Rally may find the class a fun way to sharpen the precision of their skills.

Prerequisites/ Notes:

- Participants must have completed a Family Pet Dog Manners/Basic Obedience Class or a Puppy class with recommendation from your teacher
- Dogs must be accompanied by an adult handler
- These classes may be filmed for instructional purposes
